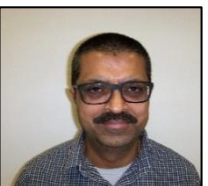
Lesley Hall- Co-opted Governor

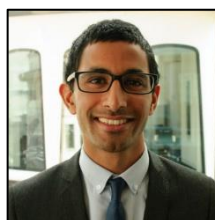
Jordan Styles- Staff Governor- Governor Link for Anti-Bullying
