#### **CHAIR'S REPORT**

Hope you had a good Easter break. It's been so good to have some sunshine at last.

The FREE training sessions for LAS members and extended family started in March, and received really good evaluations. Kevin Baskerville and the Autism Outreach Team have done a great job presenting these sessions on topics that are of such importance to parents, carers, friends, spouses and loved ones of children and adults with Autism. These sessions are also suitable as "refreshers" for those folks whose children/adults have had a diagnosis for a while. I found them quite useful myself, considering our daughter is now 15yrs old, and was diagnosed at age 3yrs. Although I did the Early Bird and Autism Outreach courses over the years, I can't remember everything. Especially as the child ages, issues and behaviours either change or appear depending on the age & circumstances.

We are once again offering these courses in May, June and early July. If you missed any in the Spring, now is the chance to attend one or more (See info & registration form inside this LINKUP)

Please note: these courses are being offered this year instead of the Conference the LAS usually held every other year. In 2013 after much planning, and then having to cancel the one-day Saturday Conference in June due to low registrations, the Committee discussed other ways of offering training to families. Understandably, childcare on a weekend was a big issue, yet the need for information was necessary so we decided upon weekday & evening course offerings for 2015. If we receive more funding, we may be able to hold more training in 2016. Please contact us if you have any ideas for other training topics, or to vote for the same type of training. WE WON'T KNOW IF YOU DON'T TELL US.

Despite World Autism Awareness Day and the kickoff of Awareness Month falling during the Easter hols, some parents and groups managed to have information stands on the day, and also held "Bag-packing collection & info events" at a couple of Sainsbury's supermarkets throughout April in the Wigston and Market Harborough. Those monies will benefit the Jigsaw Youth Club in Wigston and the Market Harborough Holiday Club. Many LAS Leaflets were handed out to the public, and it's still amazing and concerning how many people still don't know much about Autism. Quite touching however, was the generosity and kindness of many people. Between both groups over £1,000 was raised. Both groups also raised funds wrapping flowers at these supermarkets for Mothering Sunday weekend. Many thanks to all those volunteers who gave their

time for our cause. We even had grandmas, cousins and family friends helping, which was great to see. 

#### **FUNDRAISING NEWS & THANK YOUS**

Many thanks to Claire Merriman for her donation of £185 to the LAS in April in memory of her mother Francis James, who died last year aged 94 years. Claire has a son with autism and lives in Leicestershire. A very kind and thoughtful donation.

A very belated THANK YOU to Yvonne Fenwick of Musgrave Ltd, who created and donated 2 Kiddies Baskets and 2 Adult Baskets for the Jigsaw Mkt Harborough Holiday Club raffle held at an LAS information stand in Sainsburys' Market Harborough foyer in September 2014. Mrs Fenwick is the auntie of one of our Holiday Club children, and her sister inlaw Donna Johnson, currently organises the activities and venues for the Club. Donna and at least 5 Holiday Club mums also shook tins and buckets at this time, raising £270. Also, the Mkt Harborough Holiday Club mums and some of the children, spent over 6 hours "Bag Packing" and collecting for the Jigsaw LAS Holiday Club at Sainsburys on 21st December 2014, raising over £350! 

Adult Autism Strategy Statutory Guidance published New guidance for local authorities and NHS organisations

The <u>statutory guidance</u> updates original guidance issued under the Autism Act 2009 and the subsequent Adult Autism Strategy. It accounts for progress and updates to the Strategy made since 2010, and recent legislation like the Care Act 2014 and the Children and Families Act 2014.

The guidance sets out requirements for Local Authorities and NHS organisations. It reminds them to work together and with partners, for example, in the criminal justice system or helping people with autism into employment. It provides clarity about what they have to do to meet the needs of adults with autism, including preventative support and safeguarding.

The first ever Music Festival exclusively for people with a learning disability and autism, their families and carers is coming to the heart of the New Forest this Summer. The three day festival will run from Friday 10th to Sunday 12th July and over 40 live acts have already joined the lineup. The festival will host two stages, a dance tent and a sensory area, as well a number of other activities including a circus school, swing dance classes, a zip wire and a large camp site. What's more – carers and children go free and the whole festival is 100% wheelchair friendly. The festival in being run by two charities based in the New Forest – The Minstead Training Trust and Stable Family Home Trust. Between them, the charities provide care and support to over 250 adults with a learning disability in the area.

Hal Kennard, the festival's Co-Producer, has spent the last two and a half years as a carer for a young man with Down's Syndrome. He said: "New Forest Spectrum's music policy will be broad, eclectic and fun with a twist of pop, a dab of disco and a sprinkle of reggae. The concept behind the festival is audience interaction! The hardest part is letting everyone around the country with learning disabilities know about the festival – please help us spread the word!"

Camps will be taking place throughout the summer holidays - There will be 5 camps of 3 families per camp. This includes teepee accommodation and activities throughout the day and an evening camp fire. Activities will include therapeutic riding activities, grooming, interacting with the horses and other animals. We have ponies, horses, goats, rabbit, chickens and friendly rats. We will focus on developing communication and social skills as well as having a lot of fun.

We also have badminton, short tennis, football, a basketball net and archery. We provide games mounted on the horses including horse football, polo, gymkhana games and knight's skills which include hitting a target with a lance and tent pegging. There are arts and crafts, clay modelling, and musical activities with Boom Whackers, African drums and percussion instruments. Fun games, camp fires and treasure hunts are also included depending on needs and interests. The environment is suitable for individuals with sensory needs and includes the use of a basket swing, trampoline, hammock seating, bean bags and a sensory relaxing stable. Potential sensory triggers are reduced or avoided where possible. Teepees will be like the one above with the orange trim, this is made by the same manufacturer as ours. The funding for these and the camp equipment has kindly been provided by a grant from Leicestershire County Council. The teepees have full linings and heavy duty ground sheets. Inside they will have 4 single mattresses, (any extra beds, single or double, will be air beds). It is self catering. There is a toilet and there will be a shower and hand wash facilities. There are two lovely pubs within a couple of miles if you wanted to eat out. There is also B& B accommodation nearby if you wanted to attend but didn't want to camp.

The camps are to provide activities for the whole family and not just children with a disability so activities are planned to include all family members and are tailored to individual needs and interests. Parents can choose to take part as much as they wish or can choose to sit back and relax and let us entertain the children. There is no upper age limit but we will have limited activities for children under 2 and they must be very closely supervised.
