



The English Baccalaureate is the collection of subjects considered "desirable" by some universities when they are selecting potential students.

Students achieving grade **5** or above in the following subjects will be considered to have achieved the "English Baccalaureate:"

English	Maths	Two Sciences	A Language	History OR Geography
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If students are capable of attaining a Grade 4 or above for **all** of these subjects, they should seriously consider taking a modern language AND History or Geography.



Helping students make the right choices:

OPPORTUNITIES: Options booklet, teachers, careers advisor, research...

- DISCUSS: What are their opinions? What are your opinions? What questions do they have that you might be able to help answer?
- FACTS: Make sure they are basing choices on facts, not assumptions.
- **SUBJECT**: Base the decision on the work, not friends or teachers.
